#### **Swimming**

Children in YR 3, YR 4, YR 5 and YR 6 will go swimming on Friday mornings.

- 2. All children with long hair must wear a swimming hat. Children should have their own hat
- 3. All boys must wear proper **swimming trunks**, not shorts.

The NSC has also asked schools to politely request that if parents / guardians attend the NSC to be a spectator during the school's swimming time, that they refrain from interacting with the children or staff as this is very distracting and disrupts the lesson.
